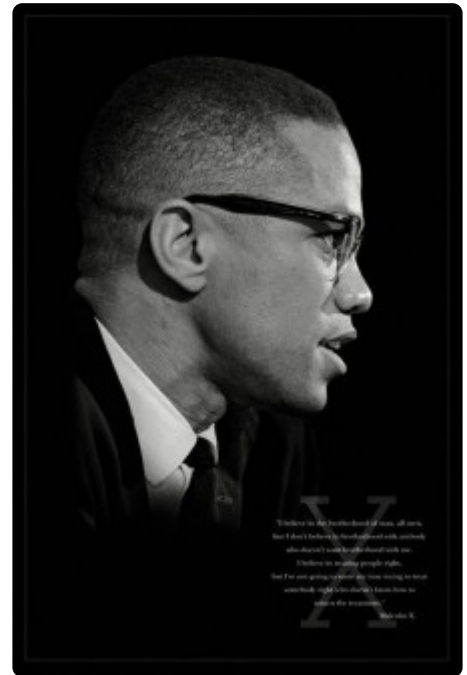


# The 18th Annual Los Angeles, MALCOLM X FESTIVAL of Arts, Culture & Education

*Because this area of the city is primarily Black/African-American, this move will significantly intersect with the Rosa Parks Freeway, Obama Blvd, Martin Luther King Blvd, Sankofa Park, and Nipsey Hussle Square. It will also coincide with the city's Destination Crenshaw Project, and most importantly, will pay homage to our esteemed ancestor and human rights advocate" stated Mr. Andre Parvenu/Msonga Mbele, project coordinator and city planner. **Project planners include: Mr. Shaka Satori, Ms. Ashley "Perky" Perkins, Andre Parvenu and Mr. Torrence Brannon-Reese.***
